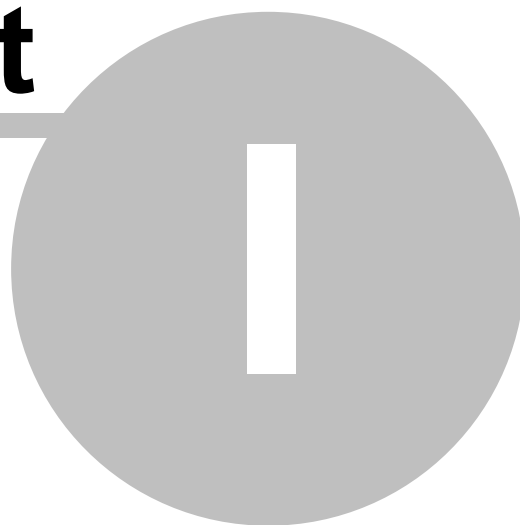

1.1 Edition comparison

PDF Imager is available in two different versions. The following paragraph shows you the differences of the available editions and helps you to choose the suitable edition for you.

Trial Version

The trial version (Standard Edition) of PDF Imager can be tested unrestrictedly for 14 days. It provides you with all the features of the software. At the end of the evaluation period all main menu items are not available for use anymore.

Users of the Standard Edition do not receive technical support via email free of charge.

Professional Edition (Full Version)

PDF Imager Professional may be purchased through the ASCOMP Software GmbH [online shop](#) at a price of \$13.90 (private license) respectively \$24.90 (company license). This edition is accessible for unlimited time.

Users of the Professional Edition receive free software updates, as well as technical support via email free of charge, in each case for a period of two years from the date of purchase.

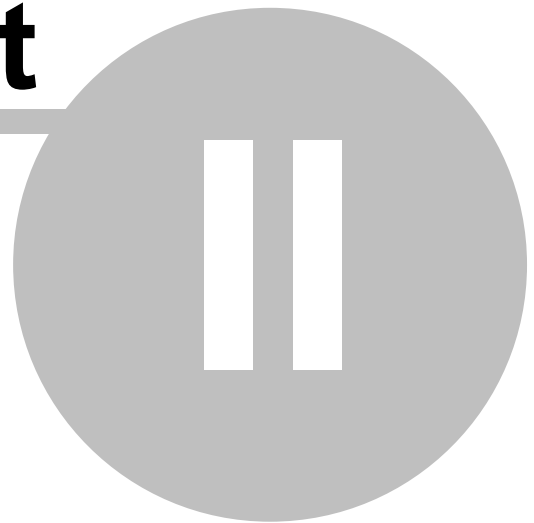

2 Save PDF pages as an image

This chapter provides information on how to convert a PDF document using PDF Imager.

Step 1: Select the PDF document

In the lower left corner of the window, click Load PDF Document to select a PDF file. Alternatively, you can also click on the lettering next to "1." is shown.

You can now select the desired PDF document via the "Open file" dialog known from Windows.

Step 2: page selection

Using the list field, which is displayed under the lettering "2.", you can choose whether only the page of the selected PDF document currently displayed on the left should be converted into an image file, or whether all pages contained in the PDF file should be converted. The original PDF file is not changed here.

The file name of the output file corresponds to the original file name, followed by an underscore ("_") and the page number of the converted page. The file format under step "3." will be used as file extension.

Note: In the case of multi-page PDF documents, you can change the currently selected page by clicking the left / right arrows next to the PDF page preview.

Step 3: Select the file format

You can use the list box to select the desired output format for the image file. PDF Imager supports several output formats, including all common formats such as BMP, PNG and JPG.

Step 4: Selection of the output folder

Use the input field under the lettering "4." to specify the output folder for the image files. The "..." button to the right of the input field enables a selection via the "Select folder" dialog known from Windows.

Start the conversion process by clicking the "Convert PDF" button. If the conversion is successful, the generated image files are saved in the output folder under the original file name, the page number and the selected image format.

Note: You can start the process again by clicking the arrow buttons to the left of the PDF page preview after the conversion process. In this way, several desired pages can be converted quickly and easily in series.



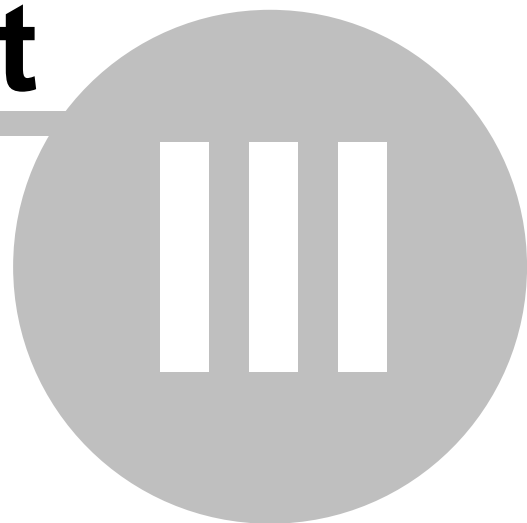

3 Save images to PDF

This chapter provides information about saving images as a PDF document.

Step 1: Select one or more images

In the lower left corner of the window, click Add Pictures to select one or more pictures. Alternatively, you can also click on the lettering next to "1." is shown.

You can now select the picture or pictures you want using the "Open file" dialog known from Windows.

Step 2: Determine the page format

Using the list field, which is displayed under the lettering "2.", you can select which page format the page in the PDF document on which the respective image is displayed should have.

If you select "Automatic (recommended)", the page format is automatically adjusted to the size of the respective image.

Step 3: Select the image compression filter

You can select an image compression filter from the list box. PDF Imager supports several filters that allow a more or less strong compression. If you want lossless compression, the PDF_LZW method is recommended.

Note: If you do not want compression, select the "No compression" option.

Step 4: Select output file name

Use the input field under the lettering "4." to specify the storage location of the PDF document. The "..." button to the right of the input field enables a selection via the "Save As" dialog known from Windows.

Warning: If the target file already exists, it will be overwritten automatically!

Start the conversion process by clicking the "Create PDF" button.
